A Message from the Board of Trustees: Back in December of 2001 the community approved an \$8.25 million proposition to expand and renovate the one story library building built in 1967. This March, the library will be making our last payment to pay off the serial bond that allowed us to complete this beautiful facility. While a lot has changed over these many years, our dedication to serving you in a fiscally conservative way has remained constant. As we have done for the last couple of years, this proposed budget is not anticipated to increase your taxes. The overall budget for the library is actually being reduced by \$170,000, while we also put aside monies for two aging roofs, an outdated heating and air conditioning system, etc. It is our intention to continue to maintain this amazing facility while, at the same time, not raise community members' taxes for years to come. Please vote on Tuesday, April 5th, and help us continue our tradition of excellence in library services. Your participation does matter!
